“Beyond the Headlines” brings Wisconsinites together for discussions that explore journalism’s role in enabling productive citizen engagement in American democracy.

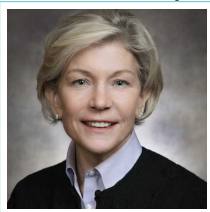
